

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders the following, effective January 1, 2021:

- 1 The letters patent issued on August 31, 1932 (Order in Council 998/1932) incorporating the Lansdowne Waterworks District are revoked.
- 2 The water service of the Lansdowne Waterworks District described in the letters patent issued on August 31, 1932 (Order in Council 998/1932) is continued as a local area service of The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen.
- 3 The area of the local area service is the area described as the Lansdowne Waterworks District in the letters patent issued on August 31, 1932 (Order in Council 998/1932) and having the boundaries defined in those letters patent as amended.
- 4 The rights, property and assets of the Lansdowne Waterworks District are transferred to and vested in The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen.
- 5 The obligations of the Lansdowne Waterworks District are transferred to and assumed by The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen.
- 6 The bylaws and resolutions of the Lansdowne Waterworks District continue in force as bylaws or resolutions, as the case may be, of The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen applicable to the area of The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen to which they applied as bylaws or resolutions of the Lansdowne Waterworks District until those bylaws or resolutions are amended or repealed by the board of directors of The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen.
- 7 A reference to the Lansdowne Waterworks District in any commercial paper, lease, licence, permit or other contract, instrument or document that is transferred under section 4 or 5 is deemed to be a reference to The Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen.

Township of Spallumcheen's Shared Cost Agreement - Organics Infrastructure Program

The Chief Administrative Officer provided an update on the Organics Infrastructure Program Shared Cost Agreement. He advised that Passive Remediation Systems provided a presentation to the Ministry of Environment in regards to the field of concern to see if funds could be redirected to this project. The Ministry seemed quite intrigued. Staff will update Council once the Ministry has assessed the matter.

The Chief Administrative Officer advised that the Orders in Council for 5 Water Districts have been received and the Township will take over management of these water districts effective January 1, 2021. He noted that residents are being directed to contact the Township from this point forward. Staff are in the process of putting together communications to go out to the districts. Each District is also working on communications as well.

Mayor Fraser thanked the Water District Chairs' and Trustees for all their years of dedicated service noting a future celebration/recognition is planned once the pandemic is under control and we can safely meet.
