2015

2019

2020:

- Watt Consulting Group is hired to complete a Traffic Signal Study to examine the intersections of Highway 97A with McLeod Road and Smith Drive.
- A Highway 97A Traffic Signal Review Select Committee is created to support the traffic signal study.
- Council met with Minister of Transportation at UBCM Conference in September

2021:

- The Township of Spallumcheen, City of Armstrong, and City of Enderby request a joint meeting with Minister Fleming.
- Council met with Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure, multiple times in 2021 to request updates to the traffic count information, manage speed, improve left turn access, address accidents and overall safety, and include the Township in the planning process.
- Council met with Minister of Transportation at UBCM Conference in September
- Concrete median barriers installed along Highway 97A

2022:

- Discussions with the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure include reviewing traffic study results and discussing potential solutions, including the possibility of reducing the speed limit and related risks and improving winter service from the highway maintenance contractors.
