

McLeod Subdivision Access



Council Actions 2023-2025

2023:

- In response to changes to the Motor Vehicle Act to improve road safety, the Township of Spallumcheen restates the request to lower speed limits on Highway 97A north of Armstrong related to incidents at the McLeod Road intersection.
- The speed limit on Highway 97A is reduced to 90 km/hr.
- Council met with Ministry of Transportation staff at UBCM Conference in September
- Council passed the following resolution:

“THAT the Township of Spallumcheen Council direct staff to provide a letter to the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) confirming the Township’s interest in pursuing the Mountain View Road main access option included in the preliminary funding phase with the inclusion of the right in, right out access at McLeod Road;

AND THAT the Township of Spallumcheen Council Request commitment from the MOTI that Ministry staff will participate in an open house with residents of the McLeod Subdivision and those impacted to answer questions.”

2024:

- A formal letter was sent from the Township of Spallumcheen to the Ministry of Transportation and Transit to provide an update on the interest in pursuing Mountain View Road as the main access to the McLeod Subdivision.
- The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure begins work on a functional design for access to the McLeod Subdivision.
- Staff met with Ministry of Transportation and Transit to discuss the functional design approach and timeline. Ministry staff confirmed once functional design is complete it will Ministry staff to seek funding and priority for the project on the Ministerial level.
- Ministry undertook exploratory geotechnical work in the McLeod access area along Highway 97A as part of their functional design work.
- Township of Spallumcheen requested that the Ministry of Transportation and Transit notify us prior to any field work so that information can be communicated through press release to the community.

2025:

- Residents provide a letter with a number of questions related to the McLeod Subdivision area. Staff provide a response to the group spokesperson.
- Town Hall meeting scheduled to address additional questions and concerns.
